Silver Jubilee Medal & Silver Jubilee Commemorative Coin

The Silver Jubilee Medal & Silver Jubilee Commemorative Coin are created by the Sea Dragon Sea Scout Group to commemorate the past 25 years and to celebrate the continue long run with Scouting in Canada.

Silver Jubilee Medal Award:

The Silver Jubilee Medal is to be presented at the St. George Day Parade on April 25, 2010 to honor our members, and those in the community, who have made a significant contribution to our Group and the Scouting Movement. This Medal is to be worn while attending Sea Dragon Sea Scout Group's special events, i.e. the Annual Gala Dinner, the St. George Day Parade, etc.

All registered and active members of Sea Dragon Sea Scout are eligible for the Silver Jubilee Medal subject to one of the following listed criteria:-

- a. Holder of the Six Stars Award when in Cub Section;
- b. Holder of the Chief Scout Award when in Scout Section;
- c. Holder of the Queen Venturer Award when in Venturer Company;
- d. Holder of the Rambler Badge when in Rover Crew;
- e. Leaders with two or more year satisfactory service with SDSS.

Each Ship's Captain is responsible for nominating members within his/her ship for the Medal award. Lists of nominees must be submitted to Commodore Manfred for approval on or before March 31, 2010.

In addition to the Ship Captains' nomination, The Group Committee could nominate any person, within/ or outside our group that deserved the medal award.

The Silver Jubilee Commemorative Coin:

All registered members who are not eligible for the Silver Jubilee Medal Award but participating on the St George Day Parade will receive a Silver Jubilee Commemorative Coin. The main piece of the medal and the coin is the same except that the medal comes with a ribbon, whereas the coin comes in an encapsulated case.
