



# Sea Dragon Sea Scouts

## Code of Conduct

### 1) Dress Code

- a. Wear standard uniform in all regular meetings and formal scouting events unless otherwise specified.  
Standard uniform includes:
  - Beavers - Official Beaver hat with tail, group Beaver shirt, Beaver vest, group neckerchief and navy blue trousers with/without belt.
  - Cubs, Scouts and Venturers - Official section hat, group uniform shirt (with epaulettes if applicable), group neckerchief with woggle, navy blue trousers with group belt.
  - Boatswain pipe with group lanyard for all Scouts and Venturers.
  - Black shoes and black socks for all members.
- b. Wear "rig-of-the-day" outfit in all other activities and the regular meeting at the last week of each month.  
"Rig-of-the-day" outfit includes:
  - Group T-shirt or polo shirt.
  - Group wind jacket if needed.
- c. Ear-ring, fashion glasses, hair coloring and heavy make-up are not allowed in all meetings or scouting events, unless approved by skipper.
- d. Neat and presentable hair style is expected for members. Female members must tie their long hair to form a ponytail with either navy blue or black colored bend that is approved by skipper.

### 2) Responsibilities

- a. Attend all regular meetings, fundraising events and mandatory events. All absence must be pre-approved by member's parent and the section leader.
- b. Arrive at least 5 minutes before the starting time of regular meetings, events and activities.
- c. Duty crew members must arrive at least 15 minutes before the starting time of regular meetings for hoist set-up.
- d. Notify section leader in advance of any absence or leave from meetings/events.
- e. Bring stationery and a black/blue binder to all regular meetings.
- f. Assist in cleaning up the meeting place and take all belongings home after each meeting.

- g. Observe and meet all deadlines of submission (e.g. forms, fees and assignments).
- h. Experienced/elder members are to take care of new/younger members and offer immediate help as if in a family whenever necessary.
- i. For any signed-up services arrive on-time and notify skippers in advance if change of schedule.

### **3) Obedience**

- a. Obey orders and follow instructions given by skippers, boatswain and crew leaders.

### **4) Behaviours**

- a. Behave in accordance to the spirit of the section's Motto, Law and Promise.
- b. Salute to all skippers at the first sight during the day and also after dismissal at regular meetings, scouting activities and events.
- c. Listen and no talking while skipper/boatswain/crew leader is speaking.
- d. Drugs, alcohol, fighting, horse playing and bullying are not allowed at all time.
- e. Knives, toys, electronic devices, playing cards are prohibited during regular meetings and events except approved by skipper. Cellular phone in silence mode is allowed.
