

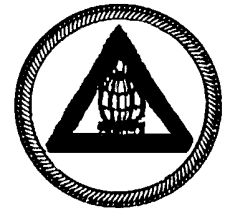

Pet Care

1. Look after a pet for at least six months.
2. show the required feeding, grooming, exercise, affection, and training that a specific pet needs.
3. Know the laws in your community that apply to keeping a pet.
4. Show that you understand what is considered cruelty to animals.
5. Explain the different health risks associated with wild animals versus domesticated pets.
6. Visit a veterinary hospital, or equivalent, to learn about preventive services available to your pet.

Safety



1. Show how to get help (e.g. from police, firefighters, ambulance).
2. Explain the different classes of fires, and how to use different type of fire extinguishers.
3. Demonstrate the safety aspects, and differences between fuses and circuit breakers.
4. Show what to do if a fire starts. Plan escape routes for your home and meeting place. Know where fire extinguishers and smoke alarms are located.
5. Make a list of fire hazards in your home and meeting place.
6. Demonstrate how and why you should store medicines, cleaning aids and flammable materials. Be able to identify the hazard symbols.
7. Demonstrate the basic "Rules of the Road" for bicycling.
8. Show how to avoid and treat carbon monoxide poisoning
9. Identify common poisonous plants in your area, and how to treat them.
