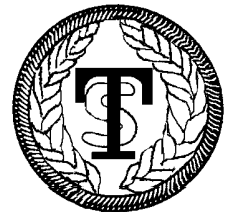
Individual Specialty

1. A scout may propose a subject and requirements for this badge, or may develop them in cooperation with other troop members. The requirements should be presented to the patrol meeting or Court of Honour for review.
2. Topics selected for this badge should not be covered in any other Challenge Badge.
3. The Scout Leader must send a copy of the badge requirements to the local Scout council for information.
4. A Scout may hold only one Individual Specialty Badge at a time.
5. A Scout may choose a new Individual Specialty once a year.



Language Strip

1. Show you know a language other than your own by talking on a subject of your choice for 15 minutes.
2. The person whom you are speaking or reporting to must agree that your pronunciation, grammar, and spelling are basically correct and age-appropriate.



Troop Specialty

1. The troop will identify the requirements for this badge.
2. The Scout Leader must send a copy of the badge requirements to the local Scout council for information.
3. A troop may have only one Specialty Badge at a time.
4. A troop may change its Specialty Badge once a year if it wishes
